The City Council of the City of Lanett, Alabama, met on Monday, August 3, 2020, in the Council Chambers at City Hall at 6:00 P.M.

Council members present were Tony Malone, Jamie Heard, Angelia Thomas and John Motley. Mayor Kyle McCoy presided over the meeting.

The Invocation was given by Reverend Rodney Jones. Mayor McCoy led the pledge of allegiance.

The Agenda was approved through a motion by council member Malone and seconded by council member Heard. Motion unanimously carried.

The Minutes from July 27th meeting were approved through a motion by council member Thomas and seconded by council member Motley. Motion unanimously carried.

Under New Business Mayor Kyle McCoy asked for a motion for approval of Invoices as submitted by the Clerk/Treasurer. Council member Heard made the motion and council member Thomas seconded the motion. Motion unanimously carried.

Resolution 08-20-01 a Resolution for the approval of Municipal Officers/Poll Workers for the upcoming election to be held on Tuesday, August 25, 2020. The resolution was motioned by Councilmember Motley and seconded by Councilmember Heard. Motion unanimously carried.

Resolution 08-20-02 a Resolution to amend Resolution 07-20-05 for the Renewal of Credit Line with Renasant Bank was put into motion by council member Malone. Council member Thomas seconded the motion. Motion unanimously carried. City Clerk Gilbert explained the need for this amendment.

Resolution 08-20-03 a Resolution accepting low paving bid for Bid##2020-PAV-005 to Chris Clark Grading and Paving for \$135,000.00. The resolution was put into motion by council member Malone. Council member Motley seconded the motion. Motion unanimously carried.

Reports of Standing Committees:

Councilman Tony Malone- Councilman Malone had no committee report. **Councilman Jamie Heard**- Councilman Heard had no committee report.

Councilman Charles Looser- Councilman Looser was absent. Mayor McCoy announced that Looser was absent due to his son being promoted to Lt. Colonel in the United States Air Force.

Councilwoman Angelia Thomas- Councilwoman Thomas had no committee report. She also wished to offer condolences to the family of Lanett High School recent graduate Quae Houston who passed away.

Councilman John Motley – Councilman Motley had no committee report.

Mayor McCoy also urged everyone to participate in the 2020 Census. Additionally, he announced that a project grant in the amount of 8.5 million dollars has been granted to the city.
