Regular Session -

The City Council of the City of Lanett, Alabama, met on Monday, October 05, 2020, in the Council Chambers at City Hall at 6:00 P.M.

Council members present were Tony Malone, Jamie Heard, Angelia Thomas, Charles Looser and John Motley. Mayor Kyle McCoy presided over the meeting.

The Invocation was given by Reverend Rodney Jones. Mayor McCoy led the pledge of allegiance.

The Agenda was approved through a motion by council member Malone and seconded by council member Looser. Motion unanimously carried.

The Minutes from September 21st meeting were approved through a motion by council member Heard and seconded by council member Motley. Motion unanimously carried.

A Certificate for Community Service was presented to Deborah Render, a citizen of N. 6th Street in Lanett by Councilwoman Thomas.

Under New Business Mayor Kyle McCoy asked for a motion for approval of Invoices as submitted by the Clerk/Treasurer. Council member Malone made the motion and council member Heard seconded the motion. Motion unanimously carried. Councilwoman Thomas commented on the cost of the repairs to the fountain in downtown and asked that we place cameras in this area. Mayor McCoy commented that cameras had already been placed in this area.

Reports of Standing Committees:

Councilman Tony Malone- Councilman Malone had no committee report.

Councilman Jamie Heard- Councilman Heard had no committee report.

Councilman Charles Looser- Councilman Looser had no committee report.

Councilwoman Angelia Thomas- Councilwoman Thomas had no committee report.

Councilman John Motley – Councilman Motley had no committee report. He also reminded everyone of the run-off election for District 5 coming up the next day.

Mayor McCoy stated that on Wednesday, October 9th power would off for approximately 2 hours in the area of North Lanier Avenue from 5th to 7th street due to the installation of new fire hydrant.

Mayor McCoy also stated that Lanett High Coach Story wanted to remind everyone that the regular scheduled football game had been moved from Friday to Thursday night due to impending weather. He also announced that Valley High School has suspended their football season due to players testing positive for Covid-19.

Mayor McCoy reminded everyone to please complete their Census, which had been extended through the end of the month. He stated that by not doing so, the community would lose some much-needed funds.

Mayor McCoy announced that all Council members had been presented with a copy of the proposed new budget that would be placed on the Agenda for October 19th.

Councilman Malone asked about reopening the parks and other areas in the city. At this time Mayor McCoy asked for discussion on this subject.

Mayor McCoy asked for an update from Jody Lowery, who gave an update on the progress of the Airport Improvement. Lowery stated that the job was 95% complete as of today.

Councilwoman Thomas asked about an issue with a gas line. Jason Abernathy responded to her question.

City Clerk Deborah Gilbert announced that a Canvass meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, October 13th at 12:00 noon. The purpose of this meeting is to certify the election results.

Mayor McCoy thanked members of the Finance Department for working on closing out the fiscal year.

Mayor McCoy stated that there being no further business to come before this council, motion duly made, the meeting adjourned at 6:25 p.m.
