Regular Session -

The City Council of the City of Lanett, Alabama, met on Monday, July 6, 2020, in the Council Chambers located at Lanett City Hall at 6:00 P.M.

Council members present were Tony Malone, Jamie Heard, Charles Looser, Angelia Thomas and John Motley. Mayor Kyle McCoy presided over the meeting.

Mayor McCoy called Rev. Rodney Jones to come up and give the invocation. The pledge of allegiance was led by Mayor McCoy.

The Agenda was approved through a motion by council member Malone and seconded by council member Heard. Motion unanimously carried.

The Minutes from June 15th meeting were approved through a motion by council member Thomas and seconded by council member Heard. Motion unanimously carried.
