Work Session -

The Lanett City Council met on Monday, November 18, 2024, at the Lanett City Hall at 5:00 P.M.

Mayor Jamie Heard called the Work Session to order and welcomed everyone. Present at the work session were Councilmembers Malone, Autry, Thomas, Tucker and Dobbs. Mayor Heard presided over the meeting.

Mayor Heard introduced Danz Frazier of the Chattahoochee Humane Society. Frazier introduced Holly Wheeler, Board Member and John Radford, Board Vice President. Frazier explained that the main objective was to get the new contract between the City of Lanett and the Humane Society signed. He stated that our current agreement was for 4 kennels for a 14-day period because the first week they had to wait for the animal to be claimed and the second week was for an adoption effort. He also stated that the society is a no-kill organization (unless the animal is dangerous or ill) The City of Valley is currently doing renovations according to Frazier. He stated that we could double our number of kennels to 8 and the monthly invoice would also double. Our current fee for 4 kennels is \$3,229.16 per month and the new fee of \$6,458.34 per month is for 8 kennels. Chief McCain asked that they send us a daily report of intakes.

Next on the Agenda, Councilman Dobbs spoke of a piece of land that the city owns off Cherry Drive that he felt would be a great spot for a park named after former Mayor Oscar Crawley. Councilman Malone felt that the focus should be on the riverfront land and that the spot on Cherry Drive was in his district and residents there did not want a park.

Mayor Heard asked for a motion and second to adjourn the meeting. Councilmember Thomas gave the motion, and it was seconded by Councilmember Tucker. The meeting adjourned at 5:56 p.m.
