Work Session -

The City Council of the City of Lanett, Alabama, met on Monday, October 16, 2023, at the Lanett City Hall at 5:45 P.M.

Council members present were Tony Malone, Tamalita Autry, Ronnie Tucker, Angelia Thomas, and Tifton Dobbs. Mayor Jamie Heard presided over the meeting, opened the work session, and welcomed everyone.

Mayor Heard introduced Lanett district 2 citizen Michael Woody who came before the council asking for the city's assistance in getting sewage run to his home in the West Shawmut community. Woody stated that there were several lots surrounding his that would possibly be additional sewage customers to follow. He had received a quote from Harmon Engineering in the amount of \$24,000, which he would pay one half of this amount. City Attorney Stanley Gray commented stating that we have to make sure that we are being consistent in our actions. Dobbs felt it was worth the future investment. Malone asked that we do a study to determine how many more homes might be built in the area.

The next item of discussion concerned a citizen whose home was next to the city's Veteran Park. Councilman Tucker was contacted and told that the leaves from the trees in the park were shedding and falling on her vehicle causing damage. Mayor Heard stated that he had checked with Jody Tapley Tree Service and it was determined that the tree needed to come down, trimming would only be temporary. Ponders Nursery agreed as well about taking the trees down and planting something that would not grow as tall.

Mayor Heard asked for a motion to adjourn, which was given by Malone and seconded by Tucker. Heard stated that there being no further business to come before this council the meeting adjourned at 6:09 p.m.
